

NFDC India officially announces its selection for the Co-Production Market Feature & Web Series at the Film Bazaar 2024

21 feature films and 8 web-series from 7 countries showcases a diverse array of Indian and international languages, such as Hindi, English, Assamese, Tamil, Marwari, Bengali, Malayalam, Punjabi, Nepali, Marathi, Pahadi and Cantonese

National, October 21 2024: The 18th edition of the NFDC Film Bazaar brings out the official selection of feature-length projects for the Co-Production Market, set to take place from November 20 to 24, 2024, at the Marriott Resort in Goa.

For the 18th edition, Film Bazaar presents 21 feature projects that embody a pan-global narrative. The Co-Production Market features a compelling selection of projects from 7 countries. This diverse lineup includes stories from India, Bangladesh, Nepal, Australia, the UK, Germany and Hong Kong. Selected filmmakers will have the opportunity to pitch their projects to International and Indian producers, distributors, festival programmers, financiers, and sales agents during the Open Pitch session. The pitch lays the groundwork for further one to one meetings and explores potential future collaborations.

Film Bazaar proudly announces its partnership with the Asia TV Forum & Market (ATF). The Co-Production Market Feature will include a project as part of the project cross-exchange initiative.

This year we have an exciting new addition in the form of Web Series to the Co-Production Market lineup. With the increasing demand for web series continues to grow, we aim to provide a unique platform for creators to pitch their projects, build key industry connections and find potential commissioning opportunities. For this edition, we present 8 remarkable web-series projects, across different genres including but not limited to Drama, Romance, Period-Drama, Comedy, Action, Coming-of-age, Adventure and Thriller.

1 - A Night's Whispers and the Winds | India | Assamese

Producer - Prateek Bagi

Prateek Bagi, an alumnus of SRFTI, possesses an extensive track record as a Producer, Executive Producer & Line Producer. He is also a Fellowship recipient in Filmmaking from Indiana University, USA. His notable credits encompass critically acclaimed independent films, most notably the Malayalam production 'Oru Pathiraa Swapnam Pole' and the Bengali feature 'Kalkokkho,' both honored with National Awards at the 67th and 69th National Film Awards of India. His film 'Jole Dobe Na', made in collaboration with Bangladesh/US based Shobak Studio was screened at the Yokohama Triennale in 2020 and was an Official Selection at the 71st Berlin International Film Festival. Prateek is EP on Feature Film 'Mon Potongo' which won the 2023 Golden Royal Bengal Tiger Award for Best Feature Film at 29th Kolkata International Film Festival. Prateek's other producerial ventures include Malayalam Feature Film 'Narayaneente Moonnanmakkal' which is in its finishing stage. Prateek is Partner and Producer at Raging Films.

Director: Krrishna Kt. Borah

Krrishna Kt. Borah is an Indian filmmaker from Assam, currently residing in Busan, South Korea, where he is developing his second feature film project, "A Night's Whispers and the Winds" at the Busan Asian Film School. A graduate of the prestigious Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute (SRFTI) in Kolkata, Krrishna has developed his skills through multiple short films and documentaries, participating in various roles. His debut feature film, "Boroxun - Songs For Rain" (2020), co-written, directed, and edited with his batchmates, was one of the twenty recommended films at the NFDC Film Bazaar in 2020. The film premiered at the New York Indian Film Festival, earning him a Best Director nomination. It received critical acclaim through alternative releases in India. Krrishna is one of the 17 fellows selected for the 2024 Busan Asian Film Academy, furthering his cinematic journey.

2 - Aadu Ki Kasam (Destiny's Dance) | India | English, Hindi

Producer: Alan McAlex

Alan McAlex founded Suitable Pictures in 2019, focusing on original content like "Extrapolations" for Apple TV+ and "Poacher" for Sundance. Recent projects include "Sister Midnight" and "Santosh." Through Production Scope, Alan has offered premium production services for projects like "A Suitable Boy" and "Into Dust." His notable films as Executive Producer include "Dangal" and "Talvar," and as Producer, "Killa" and "Moothon."

Director - Saraswathi Vani Balgam

Saraswathi "Vani" Balgam is a creative producer, visual storyteller, and director with a portfolio of award-winning shorts and documentaries. Her expertise in overseeing production and her knack for assembling outstanding talent empower Dancing Atoms Studios to create high-quality, relatable stories with unforgettable characters that resonate with audiences worldwide.

3 - Aanaikatti Blues | India | Tamil

Producer - Madhu Mohan is a graduate of the Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad. Siva KG is a chartered accountant and an IT professional. They founded Manvasanai cinema to support the creation of a universal cinema that is grounded in our local realities. This production company began with the express intent to support young writers and directors by providing them the support structure to speak their truth. With a combined near five decades worth of professional corporate experience, although new to Film Production, Manvasanai cinema aims to enrich systems and processes that scale and apply to the seemingly chaotic nature of production.

Producer - Mathivanan Rajendran

Mathivanan 'Mathi' Rajendran is a producer and programme director based in Goa. His credits include the critically acclaimed 'Nasir' which won the NETPAC award at the 2020 IFFR and 'Nirvana Inn', a psychological horror film which premiered at Busan IFF, 2019. Both films were recipients of international co-production grants, namely the HBF-NFF and the ACF respectively. He has a keen interest in producing films which build social impact and he produced his first impact short B.Selvi & Daughters (2020) with the support of GIZ. An alumni of the prestigious European Audiovisual Entrepreneurs' Producers Workshop and a BAFTA breakthrough for 2022. He is currently the program director of 'root.ax' a transmedia accelerator dedicated to maximizing the potential of original stories from South Asia.

Director- Arun Karthick

Arun Karthick is an independent filmmaker based in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu. Self-

taught, he began producing and directing short films at the age of seventeen. His debut feature Sivapuranam/The Strange Case of Shiva premiered in the Bright Future section of the International Film Festival Rotterdam, 2016. His second feature Nasir received the Hubert Bals Fund for Script and Project Development and the NFF+HBF Co-production fund. The film competed for the Tiger award at IFFR 2020 and won the NETPAC award for the Best Asian Film and went on to be screened in numerous festivals winning the Grand Prix in the Andrei Tarkovsky Zerkalo Film Festival, Russia and Fipresci-India Grand Prix. In 2021 Arun Karthick was chosen as honouree of the first BAFTA Breakthrough India Initiative. Recently, he served as a jury member in the Andrei Tarkovsky Zerkalo Film Festival 2022, Russia.

4 - Absent | India | Hindi, English

Producer - Abhishek Chaubey

Abhishek Chaubey is an Indian filmmaker, who started as an associate director and co-writer, contributing to films like 'Makdee' (2002), 'Omkara' (2006), and 'Kaminey' (2009). Chaubey made his directorial debut with the dark comedy 'Ishqiya' (2010), followed by its sequel 'Dedh Ishqiya' (2014), both of which received critical acclaim. His 2016 film 'Udta Punjab' tackled the drug crisis in Punjab and was lauded for its bold Storytelling. Chaubey's 'Sonchiriya' (2019), a gritty tale set in Chambal, further established his reputation for crafting compelling narratives. As producer, he co-founded Macguffin Pictures with Honey Trehan. Konkona Sensharma's 'A Death in the Gunj' (2016), was their first production, which premiered at the Toronto International Film Festival. In recent years, Chaubey has

continued to innovate, directing the Netflix series 'Killer Soup' (2024) and producing the Malayalam film 'Ullozhukku' (2024).

Producer - **Honey Trehan**, based in Mumbai, is a renowned film producer and director. He has significantly contributed as a casting director, working on acclaimed films like "Sonchiriya," "Delhi Belly," "Udta Punjab," "Dedh Ishqiya," "Detective Byomkesh Bakshi," "Chittagong," and Majid Majidi's "Beyond the Clouds." Trehan began his career in Delhi's theatre scene, collaborating with Barry John and Piyush Mishra. His move to Mumbai led to a pivotal partnership with Vishal Bhardwaj, working on films like "Maqbool," "The Blue Umbrella," "Omkara," and "Kaminey." In 2015, Trehan co-founded MacGuffin Pictures with Abhishek Chaubey. Their first production, "A Death in the Gunj," received widespread acclaim. Trehan's directorial debut, "Raat Akeli Hai," released in 2020 on Netflix and went on to win a Filmfare Award.

Director - Rohan K Mehta

Rohan K Mehta graduated with a degree in Visual Communication from Birmingham School of Arts, then went on to work in Saatchi & Saatchi, London as a visualiser in the creative team. He moved on to working in roles such as Director's Assistant and Assistant Director to get a more holistic on-ground understanding of filmmaking as a practical medium. While picking Art direction and Production design as his strong suit from his time in art school- Rohan worked on a few feature length projects most notably The White Tiger (Netflix USA), Shantaram (Apple TV), The Class (Netflix India), Pippa (Roy Kapur Films), Flesh (Eros, Siddharth Anand Films). Absent is Rohan's first narrative fiction feature and was a part of NFDC Film Bazaar Screenwriters' Lab 2023. Rohan is a Director, Screenwriter and Creative partner in White Horse films along with managing director of a not-for-profit screening community platform VHS.

5 - All Ten Heads Of Ravanna | India | Hindi

Producer - Bich-Quan Tran

Dissidenz Films is a Paris-based distribution company founded by Bich-Quan Tran and focused on award-winning Asian auteur films (all genres), maverick documentary features (all nationalities) as well as cross-genre works. Bich-Quan Tran co-produced "Prologue To The Great Desaparecido" by Lav Diaz in 2013 and was an associate producer of his feature film "A Lullaby To The Sorrowful Mystery", which won the Silver Bear in 2016. She now more specifically looks into co-producing both bold and innovative auteur-driven gems from Asia aimed at a diverse audience and outstanding uncompromising films by directors with a unique artistic vision. "Schirkoa: in Lies We Trust" by Ishan Shukla, an official French-Indian co-production, is Bich- Quân Tran's first animated feature as a delegate producer and artistic collaborator. She has also just completed the production of Japanese director Sayaka Kai's second feature film "Adabana" starring Arata Iura and Kiko Mizuhara in co-production with Pony Canyon.

Director & Producer - Pranjal Dua

Pranjal Dua is a Mumbai-based filmmaker and alumnus of the Film & Television Institute of India(FTII). His films stem from a profound sense of wonder at the absurdity of the world around him. With his work, he hopes to examine his own position within a newly emergent India, struggling with its many

contradictions. His short film 'Chidiya Udh' (Fly, Bird) earned him two National Awards, including Best Direction. His films have been showcased at festivals such as MAMI, Clermont-Ferrand, Experimenta India, and even featured at the Kochi-Muziris Biennale. He has served as the Associate Director on the feature film 'Island City', which premiered at the Venice Film Festival 2015. His most recent work is a short fiction film titled 'The Flamingos & Other Migratory Birds Tour'. Through Jalsa, his production company, he aims to build a home for his independent work and also champion independent voices in Indian cinema.

6. Baaghi Bechare (Reluctant Rebels) | India | Hindi

Producer: Abhishek Sharma - Abhishek's 14-year career includes managing films like Guddu Rangeela, Ab Tak Chappan 2, Youngistan, and Irada. Known for his problem-solving skills and business acumen, he's a sought- after Executive Producer. He executive produced the documentaries Charlie Champion and Koliboy. In fiction, he co-produced Little Thomas with Anurag Kashyap's company and worked on Asur 2. He's currently producing the Netflix series For Your Eyes Only and short films Vakeel Babu and Boom Boom.

Producer - Chippy Babu has a decade of industry experience, running her own enterprise since 23. She's produced across various mediums including features, series, shorts, ads, and docu-features. Her non-fiction project "Charlie Champion" is doing the festival rounds. In fiction, she co-produced "Little Thomas" with Anurag Kashyap's company. She was an executive producer on "Asur 2" and is currently executive producing "For Your Eyes Only" for Netflix. Her short films include award- winning "Vakeel Babu" and "Khujli."

Director: Sumit Purohit Sumit is a filmmaker, writer, editor, and visual artist. He graduated in Fine Arts. Sumit's directorial debut was an experimental short documentary that explored themes of voyeurism and blurred the lines between fiction and non-fiction. Sumit received widespread acclaim for writing and editing 'Scam 1992: The Harshad Mehta Story', a 10-part series that takes you behind the scenes of India's biggest financial scam. In addition, he was the co-writer on the Hindi Film 'Bangistan', a black comedy, and Amazon Prime Video's International Emmy nominated series 'Inside Edge'. His recent works include Srikanth, a biopic of a visually impaired entrepreneur, and a Netflix series titled Tribhuvan Mishra: CA Topper. In 2022, he directed the short film Vakeel Babu (Mr. Lawyer), which addresses domestic violence and emphasizes the need for gender sensitivity among legal practitioners. He recently directed an untitled Netflix series that is currently in post-production. He is also a BAFTA Breakthrough honouree.

7 - Chetak | India | Hindi, Marwari

Producer - Suruchi Sharma is a National Award winner director-producer and founder of Studio Ainak. A graduate of NID, Ahmedabad she has previously worked on several cultural and travel shows for broadcast networks like NGC, TVF and the Epic Channel. Her work has got her several accolades including the National Award, a special mention award at IDA 2023, Forum Lenteng Award and recognition at

IDSFFK 2017. She is currently producing a feature length documentary set in Ladakh which has been pitched at forums like Docedge and Tokyo Docs 2021 and has gained recognition amongst international funders including the Best pitch award at Docedge Kolkata 2021. She is also co-producer of Gagan Gaman, an experimental Rajasthani short set for its festival release. She hopes to develop a rich and encouraging environment for film production in Rajasthan and hopes to setup Studio Ainak as an empowering space for upcoming local filmmakers.

Director- Bhuwan Somani is a Jaipur-based writer, director, and filmmaker specializing in fictional and marketing films. Through his banner, he challenges social constructs, stigmas, and taboos. Bhuwan discovered filmmaking while studying Architecture, with the award-winning debut short fiction "Innocent" in 2013 at age 20. He has since worked with major production houses including Paramount Pictures, Edunguru - Sahara India, Airtel, and Jaipur Rugs in multiple directorial and production roles and has created corporate films, ads, and documentaries that archive rural India's untold stories. His professional experience spans developing marketing strategies for bespoke brands. Bhuwan recently completed a self-funded short film (Pita aur Putra) under his banner. Currently, Bhuwan is working on his first feature film, which has been selected for the prestigious Cinekid Script LAB 2024, marking a significant milestone in his filmmaking career.

8 - Divine Chords | Bangladesh, India | Bengali

Producer - **Aadnan Imtiaz Ahmed** is a rising producer from Bangladesh with a strong international presence. He is an alumnus of prestigious programs such as Locarno Film Festival's Open Doors Lab (2016), Produire au Sud, Nantes (2018), and DPC II, Athens (2018). His first international co-production, MADE IN BANGLADESH, directed by Rubaiyat Hossain, had its world premiere at the Toronto International Film Festival in 2019 and enjoyed a successful theatrical run in France. His films have also been showcased at notable festivals including Locarno, London, Rotterdam, Clermont-Ferrand, Tampere, and Hong Kong. In 2020, Aadnan graduated from the highly respected EAVE Producers Workshop, receiving a scholarship from the CNC. His nomination by EAVE to attend IFFR's Rotterdam Lab in 2021 further solidified his growing reputation in the international film community. Aadnan's growing international presence and experience reflect his dedication to creating impactful stories.

Producer - Jonaki Bhattacharya Born in Calcutta, India, Jonaki Bhattacharya is a multi- faceted individual who wears many hats. A talented producer and production designer, Jonaki has worked on some of the most awarded alternative cinemas coming out of the Indian subcontinent in recent years. She has worked as a Producer and Production Designer in a variety of internationally acclaimed feature films, most notably - Labour of Love (Venice 2014, directed by Aditya Vikram Sengupta), for which she received the Indira Gandhi National Award. She is enthusiastic about creating sets from scratch, working hands on with her team to build an immersive world.

Director: Talat Ahmed is an independent filmmaker based in Dhaka, Bangladesh. At the age of 18, he moved to Boston, USA to attend film school at Emerson College (BFA Visual & Media Arts). Upon graduation, he returned to Dhaka in 2018 to direct his BFA graduation film, Dheu (Wave) and spent the

next four years as a Multimedia Journalist at The Daily Star. Talat continues to work as a freelance content creator for organizations such as StraitTimes, Save the Children, Swisscontact, AP News, and BELA. In 2022, Talat made the decision to pursue film-making full- time. Besides filmmaking, he is a co-founder of a Dhaka based video game studio, Red Thorn Interactive. His first full-length work, a micro-budget feature, Once Upon a Time, is in post- production as of 2024.

9 - Feral | India | English

Producer - Tobias Reeuwijk - Born in Hong Kong and raised in Honolulu, Hawaii, Reeuwijk began his professional career as a multimedia producer at The Wall Street Journal. He was a weekly contributor for the WSJ consumer tech show DIGITS and also traveled across South East Asia to write, produce, and edit short news documentaries. He directed and produced a feature-length documentary entitled 1000 Hands of the Guru, which premiered at the Asian American International Film Festival in New York and is now streaming on SVOD platforms worldwide. He is a Film Independent Fast Track 2023 Fellow as well as a CAAMFest Fellow 2023. Tobias is a graduate of USC's Peter Stark Producing Program and previously worked as an Executive Assistant to Producer Suzanne Todd and now works with Warner Brothers.

Producer - Nancy Degnan is an LA-based producer, and co-founder of filmmaker collective/production company Autotelic Pictures, whose work has gained recognition in the independent film circuit. Degnan's debut feature, "Buck Run," was nominated for Best Feature Film at the Palm Springs International Film Festival and was distributed by Freestyle Digital Media in 2021. Degnan's second feature, "Silent Notes," will have its festival premiere at the 2024 Austin Film Festival. She is Executive Producing feature "Dad Was A Good Man" alongside writer/director Nihaarika Negi, in post-production. She served as Associate Producer on web series "After Forever," which won five Daytime Emmys. Degnan is an active member of the Women In Film, and with upcoming feature, "Feral," which is represented by CAA Media Finance, participated in Film Independent Fast Track 2023, the WIF + Sundance Institute Film Finance Intensive, and the female filmmaker initiative Breaking Through The Lens.

Director - Nihaarika Negi is a multi-award-winning part-tribal Interdisciplinary Artist from India - merging film/theatre/new media with elements of contemporary performance, folktale, and magical realism. Her work has been described as 'revelatory and thoroughly riveting' (MOMA) and work 'that stands at the cusp of what could be an artistic breakthrough for Indian theater' (The Hindu). A Berlinale Talent 2021, she won the prestigious XR Market Award at New Images XR Festival (France); and has been supported by Sundance+WIF,Film Independent,Venice Biennale, IFFR's Cinemart,Breaking Through The Lens at TIFF and BFI's Film Markets,UK Arts Council,CNC. Her films have garnered critical acclaim and awards at NYIFF, MAMI Washington DC SAFF; been broadcast on Channel 4 and distributed by Disney+'s Hotstar and Amazon Prime. She holds an MA in Physical Performance & Actor-Training (University of Exeter, UK) + MFA from the Peter Stark Producing Program (USC, LA)."

10 - Gulistaan (Year of the Weeds) | India | Hindi

Producer - Mit Jani

Mit Jani began his journey as a documentary film director. His first film Goonga Pehelwan, won him a national award for Best film of debut director - Non-feature. Later he went on the produce 'Hellaro' a gujarati feature film that also went on to win a national award for Best Feature film in 2019. He produced another Gujarati film - Kamthaan, in 2024.

Producer - Aayush Patel

Aayush began his journey working on a non-feature film 'Goonga Pehelwan'. The film won the prestigious national award in 2014. Later he went on the produce 'Hellaro' a gujarati feature film that also went on to win a national award for Best Feature film in 2019. He produced another Gujarati film - Kamthaan, in 2024.

Producer - **Abhishek Shah** Abhishek's directorial debut, Hellaro, won the National Award for Best Feature Film in 2019. The film won accolades not just in India but also became an international success. Abhishek later on went on to produce another Gujarati film - Kamthaan, in 2024.

Director & Producer - Prateek Gupta is an award-winning filmmaker. In 2014, he directed his first documentary, Goonga Pehelwan, which earned him the prestigious Award for Best Debut - Non Feature at the 62nd National Film Awards. The documentary, which explores the story of a deaf wrestler, Virender Singh, received widespread critical acclaim and was showcased at numerous film festivals. Next, Prateek took on multiple roles in the making of the feature film Hellaro. As a producer, co-writer, editor, and associate director, he played a pivotal part in the film's creation. Hellaro went on to win the Best Feature Film award at the 66th National Film Awards. The film was not only critically acclaimed but also enjoyed significant commercial success. In 2024, he also co-produced and edited the Gujarati film - Kamthaan.

11 - Guptam (The Last of Them Plagues) | India | Malayalam

Producer - Jeo Baby is a writer, director, producer from Kottayam, Keralam. Baby's third feature film, The Great Indian Kitchen, became an internet sensation and a festival hit. The film, which was rejected by Amazon Prime was later bought by the streaming platform due to its popularity. TGIK has already been remade in Tamil and a Hindi remake is under production. His next production venture was Freedom Fight, an anthology of five short films, now streaming on SonyLiv. (Kunjila's 'Asanghadithar' was one of the five.) Baby's most recent film to hit theatres, Kaathal - the core, had Mammootty (one of the two superstars of Malayalam film industry) play the role of a homosexual man trapped in a heterosexual marriage. Mammootty produced the film under the banner of his production house, Mammootty Kampany. It was a critical and commercial success grossing Rs. 13.5 crores within 12 days of release. (More details in uploads.)

Director - Kunjila Mascillamani - Kunjila holds a bachelor's in English Language and Literature and made her first short film in 2009 during her first year of college. She then attended Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute (SRFTI), where she was the recipient of two student scholarships. Her projects there won several awards. Her diploma film 'Gi' was screened at IFFI in Indian Panorama (2018). After moving to Bombay, she assisted director Anand Gandhi. In 2021, she directed the segment Asanghadithar in the anthology Freedom Fight, produced by Jeo baby. It became an internet sensation and the anthology earned a special mention at the 2023 Keralam State Film Awards. Asanghadithar was included in Calicut University's curriculum. In 2023, she worked as Chief Associate Director on Kaathal, starring Mammootty, which achieved critical and commercial success. She is currently writing a feature film script for Jeo Baby. Kunjila is also a published short story writer and illustrator.

12 - Harbir | India | Punjabi, Hindi, English

Producer - Raja Krishna Menon, a prominent figure in the film industry, started in advertising, producing over 300 TV commercials and documentaries, including a notable HIV/AIDS film for the Gates Foundation. His feature film debut, "Bas Yun Hi" (2003), an independent romantic comedy, was followed by the critically acclaimed "Barah Aana" (2009), starring Naseeruddin Shah Raja's success continued with "Airlift" (2016), starring Akshay Kumar, a major commercial and critical success based on the largest civilian evacuation during the Gulf War. He then directed "Chef" (2017), starring Saif Ali Khan, an adaptation of Jon Favreau's film of the same name, and produced "Upstarts," India's first feature on startups, for Netflix. Raja's foray into series includes "BAK BAK," an 8-episode series on the growing influence of spirituality in modern times, set for release on Amazon Prime. His most recent outing is the highly successful war drama "PIPPA," based on "The Burning Chaffees," released on Amazon Prime during Diwali 2023.

Director - Angad Bawa - Angad began his career as an assistant director to Oscar nominee Ashvin Kumar on the 2011 short film Dazed in Doon, created during his time at The Doon School, Dehradun. Moving to Mumbai, he earned an advertising degree from Jai Hind College while writing digital campaigns for brands like Ikea, Hiranandani, and Times Now, among others. Angad then assisted on feature films including Dekh Tamasha Dekh with the late Satish Kaushik, The Forest, The Corner Table, No Fathers in Kashmir, and Airlift with Akshay Kumar. He also wrote and directed two acclaimed short films, Unresolved and Take 2, under Surdy Birdy Movies, gaining recognition at over 25 international festivals, including the New York Indian Film Festival and the International Film Festival of South Asia, Toronto. In 2024, Angad's debut feature screenplay, Harbir, won the Ford Foundation's Writer's INK Features Lab, and he is now focused on bringing it to fruition.
