



CO-PRODUCTION MARKET

Rules & Regulations

1. Your application must be submitted in the English language only, regardless of the final language of the film.
2. Shortlisted participants will be asked to send their scripts (with dialogues, 90 – 100 pages). The project will not be selected if there is no script.
3. Once the project is selected, either the Producer or the Director of the project must be present for all five days (November 20 – 24, 2018) of the market.
4. An orientation session will be held on November 20 to familiarize participants with the workings of the Co-Production Market. Attending the session is mandatory.
5. Multiple projects can be submitted. However, only one project of either the Director or the Producer will be selected.
6. Applications will be processed only after receipt of application fee.
7. Accommodation and accreditation of only one participant per project to the Co-Production Market will be taken care of by NFDC.
8. Travel/Airfare of participants will be at their own expense.
9. In case of international applicants, the participant is required to procure the necessary conference | business visa on his/her own. NFDC will provide all the necessary documents for the same. (This process can be time consuming. Please anticipate and allow enough time for Visa Processing.)
10. Film Bazaar recognizes only the Director(s) and Producer(s) mentioned in the application form as project representatives who will be allowed to be present at Co-Production Market, and feature in the Co-Production Market catalogue. Any removal or replacement in the team after selection will disqualify the project.
11. The maximum number of representatives per project who can attend one-on-one meetings is limited to 2.
12. The information on the application form cannot be edited once submitted.
13. Rights of admission reserved.
14. The decision of NFDC Film Bazaar on selection of an application will be final and binding.
15. NFDC Film Bazaar reserves the right to invite a project.
16. NFDC Film Bazaar reserves the right to change Terms & Conditions of the programs without prior intimation.
