



CO-PRODUCTION MARKET

Rules & Regulations

1. Your application must be submitted in the English language only, regardless of the final language of the film.
2. Your project must have 25 percent finance in place.
3. Shortlisted participants will be asked to send their scripts in English language (with dialogues, 90 – 100 pages). Shortlisted projects with scripts in regional languages will be required to submit a translated version. The project will not be selected if there is no script.
4. Once the project is selected, either the Producer or the Director of the project must be present online for the entire duration of the market.
5. All communication will be directed to the primary contact person as reflected on the application form.
6. A virtual orientation session will be conducted a few days prior to the Bazaar to familiarize participants with the workings of the Co-Production Market. Attending the session is mandatory.
7. Multiple projects can be submitted. However, only one project of either the Director or the Producer will be selected.
8. Applications will be processed only after receipt of application fee.
9. Film Bazaar recognizes only the Director(s) and Producer(s) mentioned in the application form as project representatives who will be allowed to be present online at the Co-Production Market, and feature in the Co-Production Market e-catalogue. Any removal or replacement in the team after selection will disqualify the project.

10. The maximum number of representatives per project who can attend online meetings is limited to 2. In case the project is represented by more than 2 members, attendees will be limited to 3 representatives.
11. The information on the application form cannot be edited once submitted.
12. Rights of admission reserved.
13. The decision of NFDC Film Bazaar on selection of an application will be final and binding.
14. NFDC Film Bazaar reserves the right to invite a project.
15. NFDC Film Bazaar reserves the right to change Terms & Conditions of the programs without prior intimation.
